Purpose?	To guide the Apostles into all Truth and to Bear Witness for Christ John 16:13 Acts 1:8	To forgive sins of persons and to allow persons to enter into Christ Acts 2:38 Galatians 3:27
Does It End?	Yes, Peter says it was a singular event. He says that it was not repeated after Pentecost---until Cornelius, the very first Gentile, was to be saved. Acts 11:15, 16	No, by 64 A.D., there was one baptism, not two: Ephesians 4:5. Only the command to all to be baptized in water for remission of sins remains.
